Director's Note

There is no denying that *Reforged*, like all of Last Call Theatre's shows, is an experiment in agency, impact, exploration, and not least of all, entertainment. However, there is also no denying that *Reforged*, like all of Last Call Theatre's shows, is so much more than that.

This is a show about faith. Our characters search, like all of us, for things to believe in, to hold on to, even when it seems there's no option but to let go. Faith sustains us, empowers us, and pushes us beyond what we think is possible. Faith can also lead us astray, forcing us to persevere down paths that harm, paths that obfuscate, or paths that do not lead to the places we believe they do.
